INTRODUCTION:

John 4:46-53

I. John 4:50

A. Take Jesus at His Word.

II. John 5:8-11

A. At the Pool of Bethesda, the cripple man acted on His Word.

III. John 2:1-9

A. Don't go by what you see.

B. Go by what He has said to do.

IV. John 2:5

A. Do whatever He tells you.

B. You cannot go by what you see. Faith says, 'No matter what I see, I believe Jesus.'

V. John 4:46-53

A. Act on what you believe.

B. The royal official acted on what he believed.

C. The servants at the wedding in Cana acted on what Jesus said.

D. In Mark 5:24-34, the woman with the issue of blood acted on what she believed.

CONCLUSION:

When you believe in your heart and confess with your mouth, then act on it, because faith requires action.

Faith without actions is dead. If you believe something, then act like you believe it.

PART II: HOW TO RECEIVE YOUR MIRACLE

I. Proverbs 3:5

A. Trust in the Lord and lean not to what your mind is saying.

B. Put total trust in Jesus. Lean and rely on Him.

1. Don't even think about it. Just step out and know that He will hold you.

II. Luke 5:4,5

A. Do what Jesus tells you to do.

B. Big Catch:

1. Jesus said 'Put out into deep water and let down your nets.'
a. In deep water.
b. It was day.
c. They were fishermen and knew that when you fish, it needs to be at night and not in deep water.

C. Peter acted on Jesus' Word, even though his mind said, this is not the right time or place to fish.

III. Matthew 14:22-33

A. To do great and mighty things for God, you are going to have to get out of the boat.

B. You have to move from what you are secure in and trust the Word of Jesus.

C. Peter acted on one word--COME!

CONCLUSION:

How many would agree that walking on top of water is a miracle? When Peter stepped on to the water, he got a miracle! How did he get his miracle? He acted on the Word from Jesus! We have to do what no one else will do. Peter did. And he walked on the water with Jesus! He received his miracle by acting on what Jesus told him to do. We will receive our miracles the same way.
