

THE HEART OF GOD IS TRANSFORMATION

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- The purpose of this message is to destroy the false gospel that has infiltrated the Church and left the Saints in the same condition that the unbelievers are in.
- The heart of God is transformation.
- In the beginning His purpose in creating mankind was to establish a family dynasty to rule the natural world that He would create.
- And He did just that.
- The Tree incident changed everything.
- Now they could choose the single eye; the perspective of God or they could choose the evil eye of self-consciousness.
- Mankind now has double vision—good or evil.
- The battle that we fight is in keeping the single eye.
- The single eye or God's perspective will transform a person from self-conscious to God conscious.
- That's the Gospel—Jesus came preaching good news of restoration not a ticket to Heaven.

Genesis 1-2

- Notice the phrases: And God said...; And God saw...that it was good
- Chapter 1 is showing us how faith works.
- Faith is calling those things that BE NOT as though they WERE...already visible...
- Notice the word BE—that is one powerful word
- That word creates—calls things that are not as though they were!

- Chapter 2 is the actual history of how God brought the visible, natural world from the realm of the invisible spirit world.

- Recognize God's single eye here.

- He rested from all His work in chapter 1 as though everything was complete.

- But here in chapter 2 we see that no plant of the field was yet in

the earth and no herb had yet sprung up...

- Before the garden was planted, mankind was formed from the dust of the ground and God breathed life into the clay and he became a living being.
- Then God planted a garden toward the east-Eden; and He put Adam there; **then** God made to grow every tree that is pleasant...and surrounded the garden with rivers and lands filled with good things.
- Notice that at this time, Adam was alone—the animals had not yet become visible.
- God formed all the beasts and living creatures from the ground and brought them to Adam to name; but no creature was found to be suitable for his helper-meet (his equal).
- So God fashioned woman from man—she was his equal.
- Chapter 2 ends with a picture of mankind in their original state of totally God-conscious.
- Naked and unashamed. The single eye; God conscious.

Genesis chapter 3:

- Chapter 3 is all about perspectives—how you ‘see’ things.
- Notice how Eve gave in to the way that seems right...
- She ‘saw’ that the tree was good for food
- She ‘saw’ that it was delightful to look at...
- She ‘saw’ that it was a tree to be desired BECAUSE it would make her wise...
- So she touched it; she didn’t die like she believed she would and so she ate it...
- And Adam ate, too.
- That’s when everything changed.
- Their ‘eyes’ their perspective changed from only good—only conscious of God—to now seeing themselves—self-conscious.
- And now it was all about self-preservation...

Be on your guard against the way that seems right!

- **The enemy uses this to distract you from the Truth.**
- **The way that seems right leads to death!**
- **It is vital that you know the Truth and only act on the Truth.**
- **The way that seems right is taking the easy way—it's broad and wide and easy to travel down.**
- **Stick with the narrow Way—that's the path that Truth travels.**

BUT GOD:

Romans 5:8 But Christ proved God's passionate love for us by dying in our place while we were still lost and ungodly.

Romans 3:21-27

- These Scriptures speak of redemption and restoration.
- Through the finished work of Christ we are now restored back to our original position as sons and daughters of God.
- We now possess once again unconditional authority in the earth.
- We are not sinners, but Saints!
- It's by faith, through the supernatural grace of God that we journey from glory to glory until one day Christ is fully formed in us.

- We are created in the image of God.

- Jesus is the revealed image of God.

- The Christian life is not about trying to do good until you die and go to heaven one day.

- The Christian life is about transformation.

- It's through the intimate relationship with Father, Son, and Holy Spirit that YOU will be transformed into the image of God.

- The more you know Him, the more Christ will be formed in you...

That's God's heart—for you to be fully restored to the original state of Eden.
