Our Bible is the unveiling or revealing of the One True God; the Creator God.

- It is made up of the Old Testament and the New Testament.
- In the Old Testament we meet Elohim, which is the plural name for the One True God.
- Plural because there is only One True God but comprised of three Persons.
- We call it the Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- The very nature of our God is miraculous!
- Three, yet one!
- Throughout the Old Testament, the three distinct Persons are unveiled and revealed.
- Genesis reveals Yehovah, the Father speaking The Word, Jesus and Holy Spirit hovering over the waters...

We are going to study Exodus 14-17 and take a closer look at this mighty God of miracles who is our Father!

Chapter 14

- Notice vs 1-9; Yehovah sets a trap for Pharaoh!
- Vs 10-12; DON'T GO BY WHAT YOU SEE!!! Trust God!
- Notice the language our Father uses in vs 13-18!
- Vs 19-20; do you see how strong the eye gates are in the fallen nature?
- There was the Angel of the LORD in the midst of the pillar of the cloud...
- The people could SEE IT!
- Yet they still let fear rule them...
- It was their double vision that bound them in fear...
- Vs 21-31; What a miracle!

Chapter 15

Notice verses 1-21

- All the people began to praise God with song and dance for this great miracle.
- Vs 22-27
- Won't you trust Him?
- Remember what He's done for you in the past?
- Can't you see His faithfulness?

Chapter 16

- Vs 1-3; They failed the test—again.
- Notice Yehovah's response in vs 4-36
- He always provides...
- But notice...the people had intercessors
- Yehovah only responds to faith—never fear...
- These are keys that unlock miracles!

Chapter 17

- Vs 1-7; the people are so steeped in the wrong perspective
- Vs 8-16; Yehovah fights our battles!

The Old Testament introduced us to the One True God and the New Testament will reveal what He looks like.

- Jesus is the revealed image of the One True God.
- When you see Jesus, you are seeing Yehovah.
- The God of miracles in the Old Testament is the same God of miracles in the New Testament.
- Only now, we can see Who is doing the miracles;
- They are not veiled by a cloud but brought out in the open in the Person of Jesus Christ.

When Jesus revealed Who Yehovah is and what He looks like, He showed mankind who they were created to be

- because the whole purpose of mankind being created was to have the nature and character of Yehovah.
- Jesus restored the single eye—God's perspective to us!
- Nothing stops Yehovah;
- When He says something, it is going to happen because He is Truth; He has all authority; and He has all the power to accomplish what He says.
- So live in Truth; never fear; and act like your Father!
